SCHOOL-PARENT COMPACT

School Responsibilities

Eastmont PreK-6 will:

- 1. - 2. Hold parent-teacher conferences (at least annually in elementary schools) during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement. Conferences will be held each semester in accordance with the district calendar and can also be scheduled with the principal's participation outside of instructional time.**
- 3. Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress. Student progress is reported quarterly in the form of a report card and mid quarter in the form of an interim report. These progress reports are mailed home by the district.**
- 4. Provide parents reasonable access to staff. Staff members will be available for parent teacher conferences at the school during conference days as scheduled by the district. Additionally, parents or teachers may request a conference days as scheduled by the district. Additionally, parents or teachers may request a conference outside of instructional time, with principal permission.**
- 5. Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities. Parents are encouraged to volunteer at school. Parents who wish to volunteer in their child's classroom or school should complete a Volunteer form on the district's website.**

Parent Responsibilities

We, as parents, will support our children's learning in the following ways:

- *Monitoring attendance.*
- *Making sure that homework is completed.*
- *Monitoring amount of time their children spend watching television and playing video game.*
- *Volunteering in my child's classroom.*
- *Participating, as appropriate, in decisions relating to my children's education.*
- *Promoting positive use of my child's extracurricular time.*
- *Staying informed about my child's education and communicating with the school by promptly reading all notices from the school or the school district either received by my child or by mail and responding, as appropriate.*
- *Serving, to the extent possible, on school advisory groups, such as being the Title I, Part A parent representative on the school's School Improvement Team, the Title I Parent Involvement Advisory Committee, the District wide Committee Education Council, the School Support Team or other school advisory or district and school parent groups.*

Student Responsibilities

- *Do my homework every day and ask for help when I need to.*
- *Read at least 30 minutes every day outside of school time.*
