WHAT IS A NON-ENROLLED STUDENT?

The student who plays in a practice, scrimmage, or contest with a school-sponsored team in which the student has **NOT** been enrolled (Charter, Community or Home-schooled).

Are you a HOME-SCHOOLED, COMMUNITY SCHOOL or CHARTER student?

If a student is home-schooled or attends a charter school without athletics AND the parents' residence is in the DPS district - **the student will have the opportunity to participate at the closest DPS school to their PARENTS' HOME ADDRESS.**

Instructions to Parents/Guardians:

In order to ensure students are properly placed, the following steps must be followed **(at least two of the documents below are required)**:

1. **Schedule a meeting with the Director of Athletics and bring copies of the following documents for address verification:**
 - a. **A copy of your lease or deed at current address**
 - b. **An updated driver's license showing your current address**
 - c. **An updated voter registration at your current address**
 - d. **A recent utility bill showing your current address**
 - e. **A copy of the students last report card**
2. **Complete the Non-Enrolled Student form in the presence of a notary.**
3. **No student will be allowed to practice with a team until all documents have been notarized and submitted to the Athletics.**
