

Dental Sealant Program (Five Rivers Sealant Program/Funding Provided by Ohio Department of Health)

A **free** dental sealant program is primarily available for **2nd and 6th grade students**. This Five Rivers Sealant Program received funding provided by the Ohio Department of Health. A Registered Dental Hygienist will screen your child's teeth and decide which back teeth need to be sealed. A dental hygienist will then put the sealants on your child's teeth to seal out food and bacteria that cause decay. Your child's sealants will be checked **each year they qualify**. New sealants will be applied if needed. Your child's school will send home the free Dental Sealant Form with more detailed information.
