# **DAYTON PUBLIC SCHOOLS GOALS**

Our Goals:

**Achievement:** By 2021, 80% of all Dayton Public Schools students will meet or exceed proficient rating in reading and math as measured by state and/or national assessments.

**Growth:** 100% of students in grades 9-12 will earn one credit in the four core areas per year to be on track for graduation.

**Attendance and Behavior:** By 2021, Dayton Public Schools will achieve a 5-10% increase in staff and attendance and decrease 5 percentage points of behavior suspension days with a 1-2 percentage point annual incremental change as measured by district wide attendance and behavior data.
