



# DPS Non-Enrolled Guide



## WHAT IS A NON-ENROLLED STUDENT?

A student who participate in a practice, scrimmage, or contest with a school-sponsored team in which the student has **NOT** been enrolled (Charter, Community or Home-schooled).

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## **Are you a HOME-SCHOOLED, COMMUNITY SCHOOL or CHARTER student?**

If a student is home-schooled or attends a charter school without athletics AND the parents' residence is in the DPS district - **the student will have the opportunity to participate at the closest DPS school to their PARENTS' HOME ADDRESS.**

### Instructions to Parents/Guardians:

**In order to ensure students are properly Zoned, the following steps must be followed:**

**Complete the Non-Enrolled Student form in the presence of a notary.**

**Bring the completed Non-Enrolled student form along with two of the following documents for address verification to Welcome Stadium:**

- **A copy of your lease or deed at current address**
- **An updated driver's license showing your current address**
- **An updated voter registration at your current address**
- **A recent utility bill showing your current address**
- **A copy of the students most recent report card (required, and is not considered as a form of address verification)**

**No student will be allowed to practice with a team until all documents have been notarized, submitted, and approved by Athletics.**

**Forms submission due dates by season:**

**Fall Sports - August 2, 2021**

**Winter Sports - October 21, 2021**

**Spring Sports - February 18, 2022**
