ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to attend APEX Credit Recovery Summer School, you must:

- Have a prior unsuccessful attempt of a course and your high school guidance counselor's approval.
- Complete an application and emergency medical form with your High School Guidance Counselor.

ATTENDANCE

Daily attendance is required until course is completed.

- 3 Absences = Removal from summer school
- 3 Tardies = 1 Absence
- Repeated absences, early dismissals, and or tardiness will result in dismissal from summer school.

BEHAVIOR

- Behavior will be governed by the Dayton Public Schools' Code of Conduct.
- Violations will result in removal from summer school.
- Cell phones and headphones are not permitted.
