

Regulations for free tickets to sporting events
WINTER EVENTS

Bi-Weekly Eligibility Criteria

1. **Good Attendance** Students eligible for free entry must maintain a minimum bi-weekly attendance rate of 93%. Students must attend all classes daily.
2. **Behavioral Standards** Eligible students must exhibit positive behavior, demonstrating respect for others and adhere to district code of conduct policies. Students may not have any level 2-3 office referrals or suspensions. **Students with level 2 (two) or 3 (three) referrals may not receive tickets either paid or unpaid.**
 - Students who engage in fighting on district property, district school buses, Dayton Metro Libraries properties, the RTA hub or in violation of the district's student code of conduct forfeit (lose) their right to attend any district-sponsored athletic event for the season. Students may appeal against the decision of not being allowed to attend an athletics event in their school's student senate.
 - Student senate may hear a student's petition to reinstate their ability to attend district-sponsored events. The Student Senate presents its recommendation to the Superintendent or designee for a final determination.
3. **Athletic Event Behavior Agreement** Students must read and sign an agreement prior to receiving the benefit of access (paid or free entry) to district sporting events. Refusal to sign, means refusal to enter (paid or free entry) athletic events.

Communication

1. Clearly communicate the details of the policy to students, parents, and staff.
2. Provide regular updates on eligibility status and any changes to the regulation through school announcements and communication channels.
3. All regulations can be changed at any time according to the determination of the school administration.

Doors will be closed at the beginning of halftime the 3rd quarter of the varsity games unless at capacity then, they will close sooner. Entry will not be allowed if the gymnasium has reached capacity levels as determined by the athletics team. By implementing these regulations, we aim to create a positive and supportive environment for all stakeholders.

Logistics

- All students must have School ID and QR codes.
- Students will receive game tickets the day of the game from the administrators at lunch. Those who are free will have their tickets when they arrive at the game. Those who are not free will must purchase them (so long as they meet other listed standards) at the gate.
- The process for distributing tickets will be determined by the building administrator.
- At any time free passes may be revoked if a student receives a level 2 or 3 violation.
- Building administrators will send the names of students who do not meet the free entry pass to the athletic team at least the day before the sporting event.
- Reentry's are not permitted at any sporting event unless approved by the school administrators.
- Students who are not permitted to attend based on the suspensions will be removed/codes turned off from the QR system with the assistance of Athletics.
